


ACTIVITIES

WEBINARS

- The Centre organised a Webinar Shadow Pandemic: Increasing Gender Inequality in India on 25th July 2020 by Dr Leena Pujari, Feminist Sociologist and Researcher, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Sociology, K C College in collaboration with the Stella Maris College Gender centre.
- This Webinar brought to light the issues that could lie behind the shackles of the myth of Stay Home, Stay Safe. The interaction also highlighted the increased instances of Domestic violence during the lockdown period.
- Bystander Intervention, a webinar was held on 9 November 2020 through the Google Meet platform Ms. Kirthi Jayakumar, a women's right activist, peace maker, lawyer, writer, founder of The Red Elephant Foundation and Gender Security Project; an initiative aimed at expanding the global understanding of Gender at the policy, addressed the students of the college.

The speaker discussed major strategies of bystander intervention namely Distract, Delegate, Direct and Delay.









- The International Women's Day Celebration was conducted by the Women Studies Centre and Gender Centre in collaboration with YMCA on 8 March 2021. This event hosted five speakers who addressed the college students in the Open-Air Theatre. Dr. Priscilla Asirvatham, Chair YWCA, Kalaimamani Thirunangai Sudha, Ms. Sabitha, Project Manager, Thozhi, Ms. Mridhula and Ms. Sakshi, students, Loyola college.

Kalaimamani Sudha spoke of the challenges faced by members of the trans gender community, with specific reference to trans women and highlighted a few of their achievements. Ms. Mridhula and Ms. Sakshi, spoke briefly on their experiences, the confusion and mistreatment and how they have overcome their obstacles to pursue their dreams.
