


## **Program 2: Inauguration of Learning series**

A learning series titled **B.T.S (Behind the Standards)** was launched with an aim of understanding the science behind the standards. The scientific concepts, principles and laws utilized in framing standards and its practical application in products was discussed.

The first session was on the science behind the standards for milk and milk products. The germ theory of diseases, principles of heat transfer and pasteurization were explained and demonstrated.





#### Program 3: Learning series II

The second in the learning series was on vacuum flask. Students understood the design of the vacuum flask and demonstrated through simple experiments the principles of heat transfer, radiation and thermal conductivity. The knowledge gained was evaluated through a post session questionnaire.

An expert in ISO standards, he stressed upon the importance of International standards and the positive impact it could have on the environment and health.
